



About this Network

Lady Val's Professional Women's Network organises five charity lunches a year for women of influence who want to inspire and be inspired. Guests are from business and the wider community and include female entrepreneurs, senior women in corporations, the arts, government and charity.

We provide a forum for women in business looking to further their careers by focusing on leadership skills, self-confidence and other key areas of personal development, and recognising and celebrating inspirational female role models.

The network organiser is Lady Valerie Corbett and the lunches are held at Brown's Courtrooms, 82 St Martin' Lane, Covent Garden, London WC2N 4AG.

Networking takes place from noon - before, during and after the lunch, until 4 pm. No one attends without a personal invitation.

These lunches are designed to inspire members to achieve more in their working lives and support others to do the same. Each event consists of:

- a speaker, prominent in her/his field
- an open mic session where guests who need help in any aspect of their business life can ask for contacts or help. This session is where women can speak frankly and guests are requested to treat conversations and online communications with confidentiality.
- a free workshop on some aspect of value to business follows the lunch.

A donation is taken from each booking at the Lady Val events for our work on prison reform, notably the Robin Corbett Start-Up Fund managed by the Barrow Cadbury Trust. It will offer funds to small charities to help them keep afloat.

Our expenses include the restaurant bill, PayPal which collects the booking fees and Ticket Tailor which manages the bookings. The Community Business bank account at Barclays Bank PLC is non-profit and Lady Corbett does not derive any income from any of the three Networks. As there are no administration fees, 100% of the profits are donated to our prison reform work. Lady Corbett is a UK tax payer. Accounts will be audited by Chartered Accountant Andrea Miller.

Through PayPal and Ticket Tailor, we have a record of all guests at each event in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2018 and its Privacy Policy and will seek consent should we need to use any name.
